Pascal's Wager on God's Existence

BLAISE PASCAL (1623-1662) WAS A FRENCH PHILOSOPHER



- 1. Logic and reason can never decide the question of God's existence or non-existence.
- 2. You must therefore decide based on your happiness, considering the gain or loss of believing God exists or does not exist.
- 3. If you wager that God does exist and you're right, you gain everything; eternal life after physical death. If you're wrong, you lose nothing because nothing has changed; you will be no worse off after death than you would have been had you chosen not to believe in God's existence. It's better to wager that God does exist.
