

MODES of REALITY

Philosophers of ethics believe that you cannot derive an "ought" statement from an "is" statement. A statement of fact exists in a different mode of reality from a statement of value. However, would they say the reverse is equally true? Can you derive a statement of fact from a statement of value? If true, that's politics.
